




### **The Certification Process**

- Apply online
- · Determine eligibility
- Purchase exam
- Pass exam

- Maintain certification
  - · Annual renewal fee
  - Recertification







## **Eligibility Requirements**

### Three primary criteria

- Minimum education or training
- Minimum experience
- · Passing of the examination

### Additional requirements for:

- CSP: must pass two exams or maintain a Qualifying Credential (ASP Waiver)
- CET: must hold a credential recognized by BCSP




















# **CSP Eligibility Requirements**

### Minimum Academic Requirement



· Accredited\* Bachelor's Degree in any field

### **Experience Requirement**

 At least four (4) years of experience where safety is at least 50%, preventative, professional level with breadth and depth of safety duties

### Examination(s)

Pass the ASP or hold an approved equivalent

#### **Ethics**

Commitment to the BCSP Code of Ethics

\*Degree Programs and School must be accredited. An accredited school is one that is recognized by the US Department of Education or the Council of Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) \*Note: Non-US transcripts must be evaluated for equivalency through the National Association of Credential Evaluation Service (NACES)



# **ASP Eligibility Requirements**



### **Minimum Academic Requirement**

- · Accredited\* Associate's Degree in SH&E-related field; OR
- Accredited\* Bachelor's Degree in any field

### **Experience Requirement**

 At least one (1) year of experience where safety is at least 50%, preventative, professional level with breadth and depth of safety duties.

#### **Ethics**

Commitment to the BCSP Code of Ethics

- QAP graduates must apply within one (1) year of graduation.\*
- GSPs must sit for and pass the CSP examination within six (6) years of the date the GSP is awarded.

### **Experience Requirement**

 Ten (10) years of safety management experience, 35% of job tasks related to management of safety-related programs, processes, procedures, and personnel

### **Experience Requirement**

 Have 3 years of experience with 35% of primary job duties in safety and health



# **CHST Eligibility Requirements**

### **Experience Requirement**

 Have 3 years of experience with 35% of primary job duties in constructionrelated safety and health

 Commitment to the BCSP Code of Ethics





# **STS & STSC Eligibility Requirements**

### **Training Requirement**

• 30 hours of formal safety-related training

### **Experience Requirement**

 Two (2) years of supervisory experience or four (4) years of industry experience



# **CET Eligibility Requirements**

### **Training Requirement**

 Minimum of 135 delivery hours of training or teaching in any technical or educational SH&E specialty

### **Experience Requirement**

Hold a BCSP-approved credential

Commitment to the BCSP Code of Ethics







# **Approved Credentials for the CET**

- All certifications and licenses approved as a CSP Qualifying Credentials (ASP waivers);
- All BCSP Certifications (CSP, ASP, SMS, OHST, CHST, STS, STSC);
- Certified Hazardous Materials Manager (CHMM)\*
- Certified Dangerous Goods Professionals (CDGP)\*
- Certified Fire Protection Specialist^



# **Recertification Requirements**

- Every 5 Years
- 10 Point Categories (Some with Point Limitations)
  - Practice
  - Membership
  - Organizational Service
  - Publishing, Presenting, Patents
  - Service to BCSP

- Professional Development Conferences
- Safety-Related Courses, Seminars, Quizzes
- Continuing Education
- New Degree
- Other Certifications or License



## **Recertification Requirements**

25 Points Every 5 Years







20 Points Every 5 Years







\*2.8 of the 20 points must come from teaching, developing and/or attending courses on instructional techniques

## **Recertification Requirements**



- Attend and/or teach 30 hours during the five-year cycle
  - · Safety and Health Courses
  - Presentations
  - Tool-Box Talks

# STSC

#### OR

 Retake and pass the STS or STSC examination in the last year of your five-year cycle

#### OR

 Achieve the CSP, ASP, SMS, OHST, CHST, STS or STSC during the five-year cycle
